Improvement in DE scores- 3rd grade 47% proficient in reading, now 77% proficient

School Recognition Funds: Synethia Brown and Kristin Arnold

There were 4 proposals

1. 10% to SAC, remainder would be divided evenly among all faculty and part time will be give a pro-rated amount based on scheduled hours. No employee can take funds from different schools.

2. 10% to SAC. Remainder will be divided amongst faculty and staff for 2017-2017 but they had to have worked 85% of the school year and have been a full time employee. Part time workers will receive a pro-rated amount based on their scheduled daily hours. No school employee can take funds from different schools.

3. All funds divided equally amongst staff and employees

4. 10 % to SAC. The remainder to be equally divided among all the instructional staff which receives an evaluation based on student scores. Only dispersed to teachers who have worked 60% of the school year.
