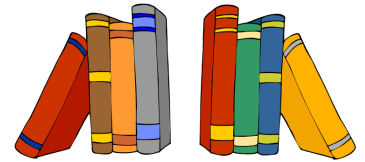

### MAY is Better Speech and Hearing Month

Although MAY is better speech and hearing month, MAY we remind you that it is never too late for you to do your part to help friends and loved ones conserve their hearing and improve their speaking abilities. MAY we suggest that you start early by helping your children to remember to speak in appropriate tones and not yell to others. MAY we also recommend that you do your part by listening to the car radio at an acceptable volume so that you MAY conserve the hearing that your children have and ensure that, as adults, they will enjoy the ability to hear their own children speak. Hearing loss is not discriminatory and it is possible that even young adults MAY experience difficulties with their hearing. Long term illnesses and allergies MAY also negatively impact your hearing. To determine if your hearing is in fact up to par, a physicians help MAY be necessary. If you have questions or concerns about your child's speech or hearing abilities you MAY contact Mill Creek Elementary Schools Speech-Language Pathologist's, Mrs. Jennifer Burton, M. S. CCC-SLP (on campus Monday through Friday), Ms. Maria DiMare M. A. CCC-SLP (on campus Monday through Friday) or Mrs. Shelly Warner M. S. CCC-SLP (on campus Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday).
