Finally, FSA testing begins immediately after Spring Break for 3rd and 4th grade students on Wednesday, March 30. Our students are more ready than EVER... Teachers and students have been working hard increasing the level of complexity and rigor in the learning, giving students ownership of their learning, and creating learning environments that are collaborative, where students are "co-creators" of their learning. As we know, FSA testing can be very stressful on our students and teachers and we want to continue to encourage and let them know just how much we BELIEVE in them!!! Please use these few tips as a way to ensure that our students are confident test takers as we approach this "testing season."

- Please make sure your students are at school **on time** – 8:30. We begin testing at 8:45 and we cannot allow students arrive late to disrupt the learning environment. This adds stress to our students if they have to make up tests!
- Please ensure that your student has a good night sleep. We all have different bed times, but we know our kiddos need a great night sleep to do their best thinking.
- Please ensure your student has a good, hearty breakfast. Of course, students are always welcome to eat at school!
- Most Importantly, **BELIEVE** in your student(s). Let them know how proud you are of them and they can conquer the world! You may just want to write them a few words of encouragement on the day of their testing to let them know how much you care about their work and KNOW they are 100% capable of performing at high levels.
- And finally, continue to talk with your students. Give them an opportunity to share their feelings, strengths, and fears! It is amazing what our children will share with us when we just sit and listen!


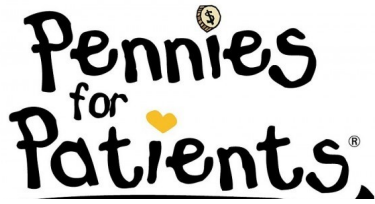
